

Dialectic Supply List—2011-2012 School Year

Please purchase all items in the designated color and/or quantity. Teachers create their lists to assist students with organization, a critical skill for dialectic students. Do not purchase an assignment book/planner. All students are required to use the Caldwell Academy Planner. Additional supply requests not listed here may accompany your child's schedule. *Optional: One large binder may be used for all classes instead of smaller, individual binders. For example a 3" or Trapper Keeper type binder may be purchased. Please be sure to buy the same number of dividers as listed.

6th Grade

- **One** large (3" or more) binder OR **five** 1 ½" binders in the following colors: blue, red, green, black, white (Please buy the ones with a clear, plastic cover)
- **Five** packs of 5 notebook dividers (with write-on tabs and pockets)
- **One** composition book (bound)
- **One** green pocket folder with 3 prongs
- **Two packages** of wide ruled notebook paper—loose leaf
- **One package** (25 count) of sheet protectors
- **One dozen** pencils (mechanical are okay)
- **Two packages** of colored pencils (12 count) AND **two** small, manual pencil sharpeners
- **Three** black or blue pens (**no gel pens**) AND **two** red pens for checking
- **Two** soft, zippered pencil pouch
- **Four pkgs.** (100 count) 3" x 5" index cards AND **one pkg.** (50 count) 4" x 6" unlined on both sides index cards
- NIV Bible, Webster's Dictionary and Thesaurus (single or combined) AND *Harpers and Collins Latin Dictionary* (found at Barnes and Noble)
- **Two** glue sticks AND **one** large eraser (or a pack of pencil erasers)
- **One package** or highlighters AND **one package** of fine tip dry erase markers

7th and 8th Grades (General)

- **One** large (3" or more) binder OR **four** 1 ½" binders -any color (Please buy the ones with a clear, plastic cover)
- **Four** packs of 5 notebook dividers (with write-on tabs and pockets)
- **Two packages** of college ruled notebook paper—loose leaf
- **One package** (25 count) of sheet protectors
- At least **one dozen** pencils (mechanical are okay)
- **One package** of colored pencils (12 count) AND **two** small, manual pencil sharpeners
- **Three** black or blue pens (**no gel pens**) AND **two** red pens for checking

Additional Supplies by Class

- **Algebra I Students** also need a TI 83 or TI 84+ calculator AND 4 AAA batteries.
- **Geometry Students** also need a TI 83 or TI 84+ calculator AND 4 AAA batteries, graphing paper, colored pencils or pens, a see-thru ruler with inches and centimeters, a protract, a good quality compass
- **Art Students** need a sketch book (5.5" x 8.5" minimum size)
